



WE ARE BARGAINING IN GOOD FAITH, CVS'S TEAM NEEDS TO DO THE SAME

HOW'S BARGAINING GOING?

Our union bargaining committee arrived to negotiations this week ready to move the process forward in **good faith**. We have our eyes on the prize: a finalized contract.

CVS's team, however, is intentionally putting roadblocks in the way of reaching agreement on proposals. They are delaying the contract, **and therefore our raises**, because they want to wear us down. This is not what negotiations are supposed to look like.

WAGE UPDATE:

Our union bargaining committee passed a counter proposal on Wages on our first day of negotiations this week. **We rejected CVS's proposal of 1% annual raises, and our proposal reasserted the value of the work that technicians and operations assistants do for patients.**

We urged management to counter us as soon as possible so we could move things along. But **CVS's team failed to produce a second counter to Wages**. They had two full days to work on a response, but we did not get one. We will need to see a response first thing in May.
