On Friday, July 31, polls opened across the country for a strike sanction vote. Strike Sanction is a critical step in an escalating series of actions pharmacy professionals can take to win a strong union contract.

On Thursday, August 6th, pharmacists and technicians in Rhode Island and here in Redlands held press conferences at CVS to announce the results of these votes.



The Results: Redlands Pharmacy Technicians and Operations Assistants voted **96.7%** in favor of a strike sanction.

In her statement to the press, Bargaining Committee member and Front End technician Aisha Torres said, "We are prepared to do whatever it takes to see improvements for our patients."
